## CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY

Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010, and the Securities and Exchange Commission Rules adopted therewith, require certain corporations to conduct due diligence on their supply chains and to report whether the products they manufacture or contract to manufacture contain "Conflict Minerals" (generally tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold) and whether the production of any "Conflict Minerals" directly or indirectly finances or benefits armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries.

It is International Hydraulics Incorporated's policy to maintain compliance with the law by exercising reasonable due diligence to evaluate our supply chain as called for by the Conflict Minerals rule, and report results as required.
